The CLE add-on supports more than 110 agency lists, a total of over 195,000 chemicals and 19,000 Form R and HAP category chemicals.

- Chemical lists are reviewed and verified each year, by A V Systems' regulatory staff. Chemicals additions are incorporated into the CLE and any delisted chemicals are deleted to keep your organization compliant with the latest reporting requirements.
- Saves data entry time for the chemicals in the database.
- Provides a cross-check of the facility's chemical components against the agency list of chemicals, so that you know which chemicals you have to report, and under which regulations.
